

AMENDMENT TO ISLEMC NEW YORK STATE CHAPTER BY LAWS

AS VOTED ON AND ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 14, 2020

The Board after consideration has determined NEW YORK STATE by-laws shall be created. Among the provisions and the basis for each are detailed as follows:

- a. It is desirable for the Board and the membership at large to become familiar with prospective members wishing to join. It is resolved that each person seeking membership in the Iron Shields Law Enforcement Motorcycle Club, NEW YORK STATE, attend three (3) events or meetings prior the membership voting to accept the prospective member
- b. As part of being a member of any organization, each member should be an active participant. With this in mind, it is resolved that each member attend at a minimum 2 sanctioned events semiannually. The Board by majority has determined the National Rally is considered a sanctioned event.
- c. The Club relies on dues for funding of various activities. It is resolved that each member to be considered in good standing have dues of \$50.00 paid by the end of January. If those dues are not paid then dues shall be increased to \$75.00 payable by the end of February. If February dues are not paid then the dues shall be increased to \$100.00 payable by the end of March. Any person that has not paid their dues as of April one of the same calendar year in which the dues are owed shall no longer be considered delinquent and not a member in good standing. A person that is not a member in good standing shall immediately surrender their colors and are entitled to any deposit of said colors.
- d. The Club does not have a desire to lose membership and seeks a method to allow members to return to the Club. It is resolved that delinquent, former members that want reconsideration must pay all dues in arrears, plus the current calendar year dues, prior to approval by the Board. Former members that left in good standing are not subject to this provision.
- e. All rules established in the National by-laws apply and take precedence.
